# **Directions and Parking**

#### SYMPOSIUM LOCATION

Georgia State University Student University Center Speakers Auditorium 44 Courtland Street, Atlanta, GA 30303

#### **MARTA**

The MARTA rail transit system serves the Atlanta area. Symposium attendees can travel to and from the symposium location on MARTA.

Stations include (rail map):

- Airport Station (North-South Rail Line): Located in the Atlanta Airport next to baggage claim
- Peachtree Center Station (North-South Rail Line): Less than a block from The Ritz-Carlton, Atlanta
- Georgia State Station (East-West Rail Line): From Peachtree Center Station adjacent to The Ritz-Carlton, ride the North-South train one stop South to the Five Points Station. Change to the East-West train and ride one stop East to the Georgia State Station. Walk North on Piedmont Avenue two blocks to the Georgia State University Student Center located on your left at the intersection of Piedmont Avenue and Gilmer Street.

#### **PARKING**

Visitor parking for \$6.00 in GSU Deck M is based on availability. Deck M is accessible from Piedmont Avenue heading north. Directions to Deck M are included after the Driving Directions. Symposium registrants have an opportunity to reserve a parking space in Deck M for the day of the symposium when completing the online symposium registration.

#### **DRIVING DIRECTIONS**

#### To the Georgia State University Student Center at 44 Courtland Street, Atlanta, GA 30303

From the North: Take Interstate 75/85 southbound to Exit 248A (M.L. King Jr. Dr.) toward State Capitol / Turner Field. Follow the exit ramp and keep straight at the fork in the ramp at the first light (do not branch right). Follow the road to a slight right onto Martin Luther King Jr. Dr. At the second light, turn right onto Piedmont Ave. The Georgia State University Student Center is located at the corner of Piedmont Ave. and Gilmer St.

**From the South**: Take Interstate 75/85 northbound to Exit 246 (Fulton St./Central Ave.) toward Downtown. Take the Fulton Street ramp. Turn right onto Fulton Street. Turn left onto Capitol Avenue. After passing the Capitol on the left, Capitol Avenue turns into Piedmont Avenue. The Georgia State University Student Center is located at the corner of Piedmont Ave. and Gilmer St.

From the East: Take Interstate 20 westbound to Exit 58A (Capitol Avenue/Downtown) and continue for ½ mile. Turn right onto Capitol Avenue. After passing the Capitol on the left, Capitol Avenue turns into Piedmont Avenue. The Georgia State University Student Center is located at the corner of Piedmont Ave. and Gilmer St.

From the West: Take Interstate 20 eastbound toward Atlanta and merge onto Interstate 75/85 northbound via Exit 57 toward Chattanooga / Greenville. Continue on 75/85 northbound to Exit 246 (Fulton St./Central Ave.) toward downtown. Take the Fulton Street ramp. Turn right onto Fulton Street. Turn left onto Capitol Avenue. After passing the Capitol on the left, Capitol Avenue turns into Piedmont Avenue. The Georgia State University Student Center is located at the corner of Piedmont Ave. and Gilmer St.

#### To park in GSU Deck M

Continue on Piedmont Ave. past Decatur St. and Gilmer St. Turn left at the next street, Auditorium Place, and turn left into the first Deck M driveway for visitor parking (indicated by a red 'visitor parking' sign).

## Directions to the Student Center from Parking Deck M

To reach the Georgia State Student Center, exit Deck M onto Gilmer Street (at the opposite end from the entrance to the deck [south end of deck]). Cross Gilmer Street and the Student Center is located at the intersection of Piedmont Avenue and Gilmer Street.
